



ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY FOR WILDBLUE SERVICE USERS

Farmers Telecommunications Cooperative, Inc. (“FTC”) is an authorized provider of WildBlue (“WildBlue”) High-Speed Internet access service to business and residential users.
